

Pre-installation checklist

To achieve best results it is the builders responsibility to ensure the following before Metalcraft fitters begin installation.

- VALLEY BOARDS**
Valley boards must be recessed to level of trusses. The outer edge of the valley board should be 160mm on each side of the centre line. We recommend using roughsawn 150x25 timber.
- FASCIA**
Timber or metal fascia must be in place as this determines an accurate overhang into the gutter for the bottom course of tiles.
- EDGE FALL PROTECTION**
Scaffold or edge fall protection is mandatory for working at height.
- GABLE ENDS**
Scaffold or a working platform by gable ends will ensure clean, straight lines on your gable tiles or flashings.
- SITE ACCESS**
Tiles are delivered on pallets by HIAB truck. Thus the closer we can drop the materials to the house, the faster the roof can be installed and foot traffic on site is reduced.

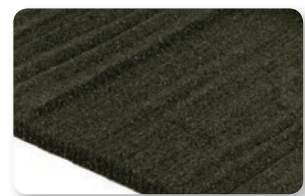

The Modena Tile is the latest addition to the Metalcraft Metal Tile range. Available in both chip coated or pressed Coloursteel, the flat design of the Modena affords a sophisticated look, with the benefit of durability and weather resistance unique to metal tiles. It is similar in appearance to a heavyweight tile, but eliminates the need and associated extra expense of reinforced trusses.

SECURITY

Metalcraft Metal Tiles are designed to withstand environmental extremes so they afford considerable peace of mind. The interlock and overlap panels unique to metal tiles are secured in place with a horizontal fixing system. Fastenings are situated at 90 degrees to the tile surface providing resistance to wind lift from hurricane force winds and earthquakes. They are also highly resistant to storm damage in the form of hail, and although they may dent, they will not crack or leak as a result of hail contact.

DURABILITY

Metalcraft Metal Tiles are manufactured from the base core of Zincalume® steel. Our colour range is produced from a proven paint system supplied by NZ Steel which gives excellent colour retention and is suited to most urban and coastal areas.

LIGHTWEIGHT

A typical lightweight metal tile weighs just 1/16th of the weight of a conventional tile. This reduces the amount of timber required to reinforce your roof trusses providing a considerable cost saving in design and materials.

SUSTAINABILITY

Trim options

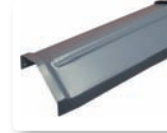
Trims are used on hip, ridges and gables and are compatible with all roof tiles, however it is important to inform your sales rep which you prefer as soon as you can.

ANGLE TRIM: the angle trim is suitable for either tile, and a corrugated option is also available in the painted finish which complements the Shake tile very well and achieves an elegant finish overall.

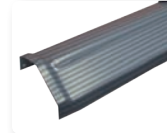

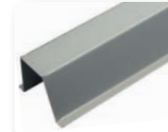

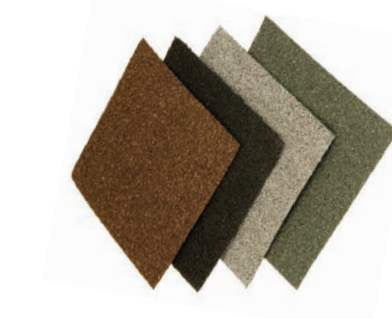

RE ROOFING CASE STUDY – MARAETAI
